Introduction

Scope

Forest Lighter has been involved in reforestation efforts with a particular focus on areas that have been damaged by human logging, flooding, thunderstorms, and tree beetles.

The following chart shows the total number of trees planted in Slovakia and Czechia:



- 30 trees in 2017

In total, the company has planted 2,509 trees so far.

Collaborations

In the past, Forest Lighter has already worked with the non-profit organizations "Make a Home" and the state institution "TANAP" to plant trees in Slovakia. This year, Forest Lighter has teamed up with the Czech non-profit organisation "Home For Trees" to plant trees together in the Czech Republic, as it is from Czech forests that Forest Lighter products come. Tree planting activities with this new partner started this autumn and will take place twice a year.
